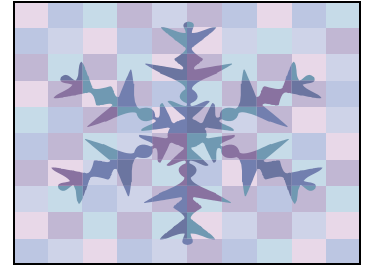
Dear Parents,

Our first round of ISTEP testing is set to begin February 27th. ISTEP remediation/tutoring invitations were sent home January 12th if you plan for your child to attend please be sure to return the permission form by Wednesday, January 24th. It is not necessary for students to attend all tutoring sessions.

NWEA testing begins next week. NWEA data is used by teachers to guide instruction and monitor students progress.

Students are encouraged to get plenty of rest and eat a healthy breakfast during NWEA and ISTEP testing windows.
