

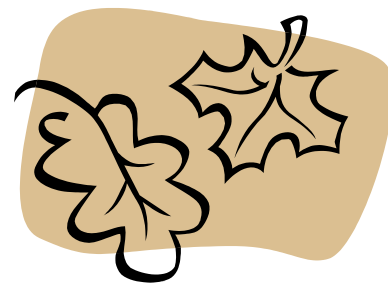
# Westview Elementary
