## Title I Program at Westview School Corporation

Westview School Corporation is proud to have an intervention team in place at each of the elementary schools to provide assistance to any student who is experiencing academic difficulty. These teams run intervention programs staffed with two or three certified teachers, as well as several classified assistants. They are trained to work with classroom teachers and administrators to interpret student achievement data and provide quality interventions to improve academic progress in the core subjects of reading and math. Westview' School Corporation elementary schools are approved by the state of Indiana to be School-Wide Title 1 programs. This means that any student in the school can receive academic interventions at any time throughout the school year.
